JOB DESCRIPTION:-

The online application "for visualisation and querying of GIS data generated in project" should be browser based & accessible from any operating system. The interface needs to be compulsorily tab & mobile friendly too.

The facility to upload the picture of maps should be available to the primary user. A separate login to be generated to upload the GIS maps to system.

- The development should be such that modules developed in future may be vi) properly integrated with this application.
- The application should be developed within 3 months from the date of issue vii) of work order.
